Aynho Precept 2019-2020 and 2019 Council Elections

The APC budget for 2019-20 has been agreed at £24,720 the 7.85% increase was due to higher salaries for the Clerk & Finance Officer, the assumed loss of the grass cutting grant of £675 and general inflation increase of 2.3% (Sep 18 CPI) of £525. The council also noted the Indicative Council Tax Base (number of council tax payers) for 2019-20 had dropped from 318 to 316.

The local elections held every four years were due to take place in May 2019, however due to the re-organisation of the county council into unitary authorities the Secretary of State has laid an Order before parliament to delay till 2020.
