 - SB TO PRESENT STATS IN MID/LATE OCTOBER
 - REVIEW SIGNAGE AND CONFIRM WHETHER ADDITIONAL SIGNAGE MIGHT BE APPROPRIATE
- OPTIONS AVAILABLE:
 - SB TO LEND APC ONE (OR MAYBE TWO) MVAS SIGNS FOR 10-12 WEEK PERIOD
 - POSSIBILITY OF FUNDING APPLICATION FOR EXTRA SPEED-SIGN MVAS FIXED (OR MOBILE) FROM PCC GRANT SCHEME (APPS BY 29-NOV)
 - POSSIBILITY TO CHANGE SPEED-CHANGE SIGNS YELLOW BACKGROUNDS AND BIGGER?
 - PAINT VILLAGE GATEWAY FENCES WHITE MORE DISTINCTIVE
 - POSSIBILITY TO BROADEN SECTION-50 LICENCE FOR WIDER USE
