The aim is to enable us all to meet together with plenty of space and fresh air and for those who would like to enter into one or more of the 6 classes, to show off their home-grown flowers, vegetables, fruit and/or 'Lockdown' Monster. The Classes will be judged by two very kind Aynho residents and each class will be awarded a 1st, 2nd and 3rd Certificate of Merit.

Entry into each class will cost 20p, only one entry per person per class but you can enter as many classes as you wish. Please bring along your **exact** money (a 20 pence piece or multiples thereof) and be prepared to put the money in the box provided (no pennies!). You will then be directed to the table to place your exhibit. (This will all be done, please, in an orderly way with correct distancing, having sanitised your hands on arrival at the sanitizing station).

You may lodge your exhibits from 12 noon and the judging will start at 12.30pm. The Certificates will be awarded at 1.00pm (The Judges' decision will, of course, be final!)

While the judges are carrying out their very taxing duties, we suggest you enjoy your picnic that you will have brought with you, remember to bring a rug or something to sit on. (With the present restrictions, unfortunately there will be no WC facilities available on the playing fields).

So many things have been disrupted by the Covid 19 virus and lockdown but the gardens around the village have benefitted enormously from the time that has been spent on nurturing plants and tending them: our **Very Different Flower and Vegetable Show of August 2020** will be a celebration of what has been achieved in these difficult and testing times.

The Aynho Gardening Club Committee really hope you will enter into the spirit of this show and will come along and enjoy the fun.
