### 'CHURCHWARDEN'S RAMBLINGS'

Autumn is in full show and winter approaches – the heating is still off in these mild temperatures and we are waiting for the definitely coming expense of keeping warm in the months ahead. Perhaps we just need to keep it in perspective and things are much worse elsewhere – and particularly these last couple of weeks in Ukraine.

As we come to the time of Remembrance it is sometimes good to pinch ourselves and remember how awful it was on the Western Front in the First World War and how that affected the men from Aynho who went to fight and died – and for the families left behind and became bereaved. The same is so for the Second World War and what the nation put up with, it under the terror and threat of Hitler – until we fought back and started defeating him. There is a resemblance to what we see in Ukraine as we watch and support that brave and determined people. We can keep all this at the forefront in our minds in these first two weeks of November wearing our Poppies. We will have our normal – always special – Remembrance Service at St Michael's Church and the War Memorials on 13<sup>th</sup> November.
