AYNHO VILLAGE NEWSLETTER

The Village Newsletter is produced by St. Michael's Church as a vehicle for informing residents on a monthly basis of events that have either happened or are due to happen.

Input is welcomed from any of the various groups which provide leisure activities and fellowship to the local community. It has an electronic circulation list reaching around 200 addressees in addition to 325 printed copies distributed monthly by our group of volunteers. The local nature of this list represents an attractive target audience for some small businesses.

All of the work in producing the Newsletter ready for printing is undertaken voluntarily by Sybil Stevens and Deborah Gibbs. Printing, although we are fortunate in having it undertaken on a heavily subsidised basis, is our major cost. The financial facts are that in 2022 the cost of producing the Newsletter was £984 whilst income was £765. The income came from the Parish Council, Advertisers, a donation from a local resident and contributions from two societies. The deficit is borne by the Church.

We already know that the printing costs will be substantially higher in 2023 and even though we have increased advertising charges they will only go part of the way to meet the increased cost. We have discussed, and rejected, charging societies for their input. We would nevertheless welcome contributions from any group or, for that matter, any resident who felt that they would like to make a contribution towards the running costs of the Newsletter.

ABILITY – THE COMMUNITY MINI-BUS SERVICE

FOR ALL RESIDENTS OF AYNHO

There is a £10 fee to REGISTER and it is FREE to use if you have a valid bus pass and use the village bus stops.

See below for the 2022 Silver and Gold annual membership fees, which offers a more convenient pick-up point or a door-to-door service.

GOLD SINGLE £45 for 12 months Equivalent to 86p per week

JOINT (at same address) £55 for 12 months Equivalent to 52p each per week

SILVER SINGLE £30 for 12 months Equivalent to 57p per week

JOINT (at same address) £42 for 12 months Equivalent to 40p each per week

The Ability Community mini-bus service runs to **Banbury on Tuesday & Thursday** to the town centre, various supermarkets & retail parks.
