Points discussed

Parking - This is resolved in terms of being able to open due to,

- Less covers in the restaurant due to furniture being used, down from 110/120 to 60/80 max
- There will be 2 parking attendants. Parking the cars, moving the cars and patrolling the building and the village if necessary
- Visitors to the design area will be able to park at the front of the house
- The current parking is being extended for staff - of which there won't be big numbers

Opening - now on track for June, owner anxious and wants to be open as soon as possible, the Inside is apparently almost ready for dressing

Lighting/speakers at the front of the house - this will be subtle uplighting and the speakers will not be used for anything other than possibly gentle music, not a tannoy system!
