Where you are tax payer and you are prepared to allow Gift Aid to be claimed on your gift (£2.50 in every £10) please consider doing this by:

- Signing a Gift aid declaration on one of the envelopes in the church
- Or by indicating your willingness to do so by contacting the Treasurer as above or by email to <u>treasurer.stmichaels@aynho.org</u>

However if you make your gift in cash into the collection plate or into the donations box or into a fundraising basket (for example) the church is able to claim the gift aid by using the HMRC scheme (Gift aid Small Donations Scheme) which adds 25p for every £1 given.
