Danylo and Juliia need to be present to run their two small businesses which need their presence - running them from their base here on Millers Lane (WFH) has been a challenge as much as they loved living there.

We will miss them all and wish them lots of luck with the journey back home, some time after this first week of August, and then for their life back in Ukraine.

### **Church Heating Project**

The replacement of the old oil fired heating system (pipes and radiators) begins this month and will be completed in the beginning of 2024. The replacement system will be a new range of infra red heating which is carried on chandelier type light units. The existing 6 hanging lights will be replaced by these new HALO heater units. The benefit will be quick warmth at the flick of a switch and at a tenth of the running cost. Very good for the environment too. There are two phases to the work - a new National Grid supply to the Church which will be put in this month followed by the rewiring of the Church for the new heaters in January. During the project the use of the Church and the churchyard will be as normal until the last weeks of the project when the Church will have to be closed.

We will announce the dates nearer the time.

Many villagers help the Church financially for which we are very grateful.

Obviously, we have Services as described on page 2- at least two services each month. We have concerts, which we advertise, and we have organised the village Fete (more to follow).

### EVERYONE IS WELCOME TO ALL OR ANYTHING IN OR AT OR WITH THE CHURCH.

*Most of all* – St Michael's is central in village life, not necessarily <u>to</u> village life, however much we would like it to be! Within the community there is support for all who need it, whether in bereavement, illness or loneliness.

Located next to Aynho Park and now RH it is a place to be visited and enjoyed – and we would welcome you to it and to meet any of us who are involved with it. If we had, or indeed get, a Rector he or she has, or can have, a part to play in what goes on in our village life.

The Church is opened in the morning and generally closed in the late afternoon.
