November is a month of preparation. On one side – Bonfire Night, children getting their lines for their Nativity plays, Christmas increasingly to the fore in all the shops, and on the other November is a period of remembrance. Remembering those who have died this year within family and friends; remembering those who have died in ghastly wars, conflicts, disasters and climate related events. We do this in our church services week in week out and not just in November – we should not forget those loved ones and those situations – they are always in our prayers and we light a candle to them every day.

We also hold a special Church service on All Souls Day (2 November) when we read out those names, light candles, and pray together – to remember and to find comfort. This year our Benefice service is being held at the Church in Hinton in the Hedges – next year it will be back at Aynho. There is a handwritten list at the back of St Michael's if you want to add a name then please do – and we will take it, along with all the others to the Service.

On Remembrance Sunday we will remember all those who gave their lives in the Two World Wars. It is a special occasion – and we will never forget the sacrifice of those generations. Please join the church service at 10.15am or just before 11 o'clock outside at the War Memorials – never mind what sort of weather it is.
